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To whom it may concern,

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You promote “Reasons to believe”yet you include in your “Statement of belief” a lot of false Biblical Beliefs that are not taught and cannot be supported anywhere in the Hebrew Bible. Most were added by Constantine/Romanism and the opinions of the false “self-appointed apostle” Paul/Saul.

Attempting to harmonize the Hebrew Bible with Science is a good thing, and we agree, since YHWH (the Almighty Sovereign Creator Power Life-Force Essence of all that exists) is manifested to us through the Hebrew Scriptures as well as through His Created Science. Therefore both must be in harmony.
