

## Summary Statement of Belief, we believe:

**The Almighty** of the Hebrew Bible is named **YHWH** (Yahweh) not God. Yahweh in Hebrew means “He-Is, He-Exists, or Ever-Living.” Yahweh is the One Almighty Sovereign Creator Power Life-Force Essence. He is the Original-Originator; without beginning; without ending; always was; ever will be. Yahweh is the non-physical Life-Force that fills His entire ever-existing and endless created Universe, sustaining and directing all using His created Alueim, the celestial/terrestrial beings (aka angels) maintaining everything according to His eternal plan.

**The Hebrew Bible**, known as the Old Testament (OT) contains the inspired revealed words of the Almighty that was faithfully recorded by His chosen Prophets to instruct ancient Biblical Israel. The Almighty’s word provides the unique complete and final authority for all matter of faithfulness and righteousness to enter His Kingdom and for eternal life, and is a guide to keep the Covenant/agreement (as it was for Israel). The Covenant now **renewed** is no longer external but dwells within all believing Israelites (Jer. 31: 33). All accepting Yahweh become True Israelites (Isaiah 56). We know of no other writings today that claim the inspired revealed word of the Almighty.

**The Greek Bible**, known as the New Testament (NT) is not the inspired word of the Almighty and does not claim to be inspired. It is a collection of various selected writings, opinions, and letters collected during the First, Second, and Third Centuries. These writings have been modified over many years to appear inspired and even as a continuation of the OT; however, the NT began as a replacement for the OT known as Marcionism - the notion of two gods, that the god of the Hebrew Bible was not the true god but that the true god was being revealed through Jesus; that Jesus was the creator-god of the earth. **Marcion’s** ideology hereby attempted to reconcile his perceived contradictions between his hatred for the OT Almighty Sovereign named Yahweh and then develop a new god that he believed was revealed by Jesus. The NT synoptic gospels record sayings assumed to have been made by the prophet Yahshua and recount events of his time. There are letters written by some of his followers, but none claim to be Yahweh’s inspired word making the NT unreliable for developing a foundation for belief.

**The Jesus** of the NT was a Hebrew prophet with the name Yahshua. The name YaH-shua means Yahweh-saves. According to the synoptic gospels Yahshua was sent to the Lost Tribes of the house of Israel (Matt. 10:5-6, 15:24). Yahshua was called “the son of Yahweh” by some followers, but he called himself “the son of man.” His evangel (good news message) was the “**Kingdom of Yahweh/of Heaven**” (Matt. 4:2, 10:7) that the Kingdom had come, was at hand, and is within believers (Luke 17:21). Yahshua was executed because of his **faithfulness**. His message was also preached by his apostles who then delivered his message to the Lost Tribes of Israel.

**Salvation/redemption** that brings **eternal life** was Yahweh’s gift to the ancient Israelites. It is now available for the stranger, (non-blood Israelites) for all who become True Israelites (Isa. 56). Eternal life is free to all upon sincere repentance before Yahweh for sin; by accepting and then keeping the Renewed Covenant that will be written in the hearts of all True Israelite believers. Because of their gratefulness they will worship Yahweh only.

**Assembly (Church)** - The Assembly is a community used to praise Yahweh and learn His counsel. Each believer can then support others through their continuous development and use of their Yahweh-given gifts and talents.

**Righteous life:** A portion of Yahweh’s Life-Force Essence will also dwell within all believers who become True Israelites by repentance, by accepting and then keeping Yahweh’s Renewed Covenant. His Life-Force within will guide each into all truth and towards living a righteous life. Becoming a True Covenant Israelite does not mean each becomes perfect; all must continue to mature and seek Yahweh for strength and direction and for counsel; to keep His covenant and to ask for His forgiveness when we fail. As members of Yahweh’s earthly house-hold each must strive for a relationship with the Heavenly Father Yahweh that continues to grow. At the end of this life on earth each can then look forward to eternal life, to be with Him and remain forever faithful members of His heavenly house-hold. We look for a glorious eternal life; for dwelling in the far reaches and endless vastness of Yahweh’s majesty; ever dwelling in His eternal Universe; to partake in His plan for us in His Kingdom, and to join with the innumerable hosts of His endless Universal house-hold. Because of all this we shout, ‘Aw-mane.’
